The normal course load for full-time students in the Bachelor of Arts program is 30 credit hours. Students with an annual GPA of 2.7 (B-) or better in the previous academic year may be permitted to carry a course load up to 36 credit hours.

Students with an annual GPA below 2.7 may also apply on this form, using the section below to identify any extenuating circumstances. The application may be referred to the Senate Admissions and Academic Standing Committee for consideration.

Thirty-six (36) credit hours constitute the maximum course load allowed in the regular year. Eighteen (18) credit hours constitute the maximum course load in a semester.

Students will be notified by email, in August, of their application status for courses beginning in September.
