 - In what capacities has the Nominee contributed to society and/or served the community?
 - In what ways can the Nominee be considered an inspiration to current students?
- Please include a short, up-to-date biographical summary (500 words or less) of the Nominee, including education, career (positions held, including professional, and volunteer) official honours/awards, and
- Attach letters of reference in support of this nomination. (The Nominator may also serve as a reference).

The recipient will be selected by a joint STU-STUAA selection committee, with the award to be bestowed at the St. Thomas University Gala Dinner on October 19, 2024.
