INDIGENOUS PEOPLES

"INDIGENOUS PEOPLES" IS A COLLECTIVE NAME FOR THE ORIGINAL PEOPLES OF NORTH AMERICA AND THEIR DESCENDANTS. OFTEN, "ABORIGINAL PEOPLES" IS ALSO USED.

INUIT

"INUIT ARE INDIGENOUS PEOPLE OF THE ARCTIC. THE WORD INUIT MEANS "THE PEOPLE" IN THE INUIT LANGUAGE OF INUKTUT."

CURRENTLY THERE ARE 53 COMMUNITIES ACROSS THE NORTHERN REGIONS OF CANADA. NORTHWEST TERRITORIES AND YUKON, NORTHERN QC, LABRADOR AND NUNAVUT

STATUS AND NON-

"FIRST NATIONS THERE ARE MORE THAN 630 FIRST PEOPLE' INCLUDE NATION COMMUNITIES IN CANADA. **AS OF 2016 THERE WERE 1.67** STATUS INDIANS." MILLION PEOPLE WHO IDENTIFY AS FIRST NATIONS.

THERE ARE MANY DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THESE COMMUNITIES BESIDES THEIR HISTORY, CULTURE AND BELIEFS. FOR INSTANCE, THEY ARE SETTLED IN DIFFERENT REGIONS OF CANADA. EACH OF THE THREE COMMUNITIES SPEAKS THEIR OWN LANGUAGE; INUKTITUT (INUIT), MICHIF (MÉTIS), AND CREE LANGUAGES, OJIBWAY, OJI-CREE, DENE AND MONTAGNAIS (FIRST NATIONS PEOPLES). INDIGENOUS PEOPLES HAVE MANY DIFFERENCES FROM ONE ANOTHER. EACH COMMUNITY OF PEOPLES IS UNIQUE IN THEIR OWN WAY.
