Admission Requirements

International applicants must demonstrate academic strength in a high school program of university preparatory courses with subject distribution, other minimum requirements, and academic standing comparable to that required of Canadian applicants.

Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate Applicants

Applicants presenting official documentation of the following grades are eligible for transfer credit.

- AP: 4 or 5 on tests (maximum of 18 credit hours in transfer)
- **IB:** 5, 6 or 7 on individual higher-level courses (maximum of 30 credit hours on a 120 credit-hour degree program)
- GCE Advanced-Level Courses: final grades of "C" or higher (maximum of 30 credit hours on a 120 credit-hour degree program)

ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

If your primary language is not English, you may be required to submit proficiency scores. Based on your overall score, you will either be permitted to take a full academic course load, or you will be placed in our **English as a Second Language (ESL) Program** to pursue your studies for credit while continuing to improve language skills during the academic year. There are no additional costs. The St. Thomas ETS Code is 0803.
